

Descendants of Robert and Elizabeth Mansfield

First Generation

1. **Robert Mansfield**¹ was born about 1594 in England² and died 16 Dec 1666 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts³ about age 72.

General Notes: According to the Mansfield Genealogy, Robert and Elizabeth Mansfield and their children were all born in England. Robert, Elizabeth, and two of their children, Joseph and Elizabeth, came over to Massachusetts about 1640. John and Andrew had come over three to four years before that. The family eventually settled in Lynn.

Robert is probably buried in the Old Western Burying Ground, the only cemetery in use at the time of his death.

Noted events in his life were:

- Will: 3 Aug 1664, Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁴ Mentioned in the will: son Joseph Mansfield; son John Mansfield; son Andrew Mansfield; wife Elizabeth. Executor was son John Mansfield

Robert married **Elizabeth**¹ in England.² Elizabeth was born about 22 Jun 1596 in England² and died 8 Sep 1673 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts⁵ about age 77.

General Notes: Elizabeth was probably buried in the Old Western Burying Ground in Lynn, the only cemetery in Lynn at the time of her death.

Noted events in her life were:

- Will: 30 Apr 1667, Essex County, Massachusetts.^{6,7} Mentioned in the will: son Joseph Mansfield; daughter Elizabeth Tomson; grandchild Elizabeth Mansfield; grandchild Deborah Mansfield; grandchild John Mansfield; grandchild Joseph Mansfield; son Andrew Mansfield.
- Probate: Essex County, Massachusetts, 26 Nov 1673.^{7,8}

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 F i. **Elizabeth Mansfield** was born in England.¹
- + 3 M ii. **Andrew Mansfield** was born about 1620 in England⁹ and died in Nov 1683 in Massachusetts¹⁰ about age 63.
- 4 M iii. **John Mansfield** was born about 1622 in England¹ and died 16 Oct 1671 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts¹¹ about age 49.

General Notes: John Mansfield is said to have married Mary Morris.

- 5 M iv. **Joseph Mansfield**² was born about 1628 in England² and died 22 Apr 1694 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts^{12,13} about age 66.

General Notes: Joseph Mansfield was possibly married to Elizabeth Needham about 1652. No record of their marriage has been found in Lynn.

Second Generation (Children)

3. Andrew Mansfield (*Robert*¹) was born about 1620 in England⁹ and died in Nov 1683 in Massachusetts¹⁰ about age 63.

General Notes: "Andrew Mansfeild, aged about sixty years..." made a deposition in Essex County Court in March 1682 concerning his father's lands.

"Andrew Mansfield, aged about thirtey eight years, testifyeth that hee hath been an inhabitant of the Towne of Lynn about two or three & twentye years... Sworne in Court held at Ipswich the 26 of March 1661. Robert Lord, clerke."

This would put Andrew's birth about 1623 and he would have come to Lynn about 1638/39.

Noted events in his life were:

- Residence: Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.
- Will: 1 Jun 1679, Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁴ Mentioned in the will: son Andrew Mansfeild; son Danll Mansfeild; four daughters, Hannah Conant, Bethiah Conant, Lydia & Deborah; brother Joseph Mansfeild, executor.
- Codicil to will: 19 Nov 1683, Boston, Suffolk, Massachusetts.¹⁵ Mentioned in codicil; dear and loving wife Elizabeth Mansfeild; daughter Rebecca [dau of Elizabeth and her husband Lot Conant]
- Probate: 28 Nov 1683, Salem, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁵

Andrew married **Bethiah**. Bethiah died 2 Jul 1672 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁶

General Notes: Bethiah's surname may be Townsend. Or Gedney (per Find A Grave)

There is a death listed in the Lynn Vital Records for Mansfeild, Bethia, daughter of Andrew, who died 2 July 1672. This is more likely Andrew's wife, not his daughter. His daughter Bethiah married John Conant in 1678. Andrew remarried in 1673 to Mary Lawes, his second wife.

- + 9 F iv. **Bethiah Mansfield**^{21,22,23} was born 7 Apr 1658 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²² and died 27 Jul 1720 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts^{21,23} at age 62.
- 10 F v. **Mary Mansfield** was born 7 Mar 1660 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²⁴ and died 15 Sep 1661 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²⁵ at age 1.
Mary married someone. Marriage status: unmarried.
- 11 F vi. **Lydia Mansfield**²⁶ was born 15 Aug 1662 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²⁷ and died 14 Sep 1726 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²⁸ at age 64.
Lydia married **William Farrington**²⁹ 6 Apr 1683 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.²⁹
- + 12 F vii. **Deborah Mansfield**³⁰ was born 1 Jan 1667 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.³⁰
- 13 M viii. **Deacon Daniel Mansfield**³¹ was born 9 Jun 1669 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts,^{31,32} died 11 Jun 1728 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts^{31,33} at age 59, and was buried in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.^{31,34}

General Notes: Gravestone Inscription for Deacon Daniel Mansfield, Lynn Western Burial Ground:

Here lyes Buried, ye Body of Deacon, Daniel Mansfield, Who Decd. June ye, 11th anno Domni. 1728.

Another record of the gravestone inscription gives his age as 59 years.

Noted events in his life were:

- Cemetery: Lynn Western Burial Ground, Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.³⁵ Gravestone inscription from the Old Burying Ground:
Here lyes Buried ye Body of Deacon Daniel Mansfield Who Decd. June ye 11th anno Domni. 1728

Daniel married **Hannah Johnson**. Hannah died 6 Sep 1714 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.³⁶

General Notes: An extraction of the gravestone inscriptions: Hannah, wife of Mr. Daniel MANSFIELD, ae 45 yrs (no date).

Daniel next married **Margarit Jarvis**³⁷ 12 May 1715 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.³⁸

General Notes: Margarit Burrill, widow of Samuell Burrill, was the second wife of Daniel Mansfield. Margerrit Jarvis of Boston and Samuell Burrel, were married in Boston, on 14 Sept 1697, by Cotton Mather. An intention was recorded and the marriage is also recorded in Lynn.

Andrew next married **Mary Lawes**,³⁹ daughter of **Francis Lawes**, 4 Jun 1673 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁴⁰ Mary died 27 Jun 1681 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁴²

General Notes: According to one website, Mary Lawes was the daughter and only child of Francis & Lydia Lawes. She married John Neale and after he died, she married Andrew Mansfield. I have not found a marriage to John Neale nor his death.

Andrew next married **Elizabeth Walton**,⁴³ daughter of **Rev. William Walton**⁴³ and **Elizabeth Cooke**, 10 Jan 1682 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁴⁴ Elizabeth was born 27 Oct 1629 in Seaton, Devonshire, England,^{45,46,47,48} was christened 27 Oct 1629 in Seaton, Devonshire, England,^{43,49} and died after 1683.⁵⁰

General Notes: Elizabeth Walton was the daughter of William Walton and Elizabeth Cooke. In an article, "Mr. William Cooke, Father-in-law of Mr. William Walton of Marblehead, Massachusetts", by Harold F. Porter, Jr., his extensive research concludes that Elizabeth Cooke and William Walton were married at Holy Trinity, Dorchester, Dorset, England on 10 April 1627. She was recorded in the record as Elizabeth Cake, rather than Cooke.

Elizabeth Cooke, Elizabeth Walton's mother, was born most likely at Crediton, Devon, one of seven children, ca. 1602. She is in her father's will, in 1614/15, as Elizabeth Cooke and in the will of her mother's sister, Mary Terry, in 1637, as Elizabeth Walton. Elizabeth Cooke and William Walton had seven children; Elizabeth Walton was the second child, born at Seaton in Devon 8m 27d 1629 which would have been 27 October 1629.

The article by Harold F. Porter, Jr., appeared in the New England Historical and Genealogical Register and was accessed at the NewEnglandAncestors.org website.

Elizabeth Walton Conant was the mother of John Conant who was married to Bethiah Mansfield. Bethiah's mother died and John's father died and their parents, both widowers, married each other.

Samuel married **Sarah Barsham** 4 Mar 1674 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁵¹

- 16 F iii. **Bathiah Mansfield** was born 13 Mar 1679 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.⁵⁴

8. Hannah Mansfield²⁰ (*Andrew², Robert¹*).

Hannah married **Nathaniel Conant**,⁵⁵ son of **Lot Conant**⁵⁶ and **Elizabeth Walton**,⁴³ Nathaniel was born 28 Jul 1650 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁵⁷ and died in 1732^{58,59} at age 82.

Children from this marriage were:

- 17 M i. **Nathaniel Conant** was born 3 Jan 1679 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts^{60,61} and was christened 7 Mar 1680 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁶⁰
- 18 M ii. **Josiah Conant** was born 26 Nov 1681 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁶² and was christened 27 Nov 1681 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁶³
- 19 F iii. **Hannah Conant** was born 25 Jan 1683 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁶⁴ and was christened 14 Sep 1684 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁶⁵
- 20 F iv. **Martha Conant** was born 24 Feb 1687 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁶⁶ and was christened 3 Jul 1687 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁶⁷
- 21 M v. **Lot Conant** was born in 1689 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁶⁸ and was christened 20 Oct 1689 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁶⁹

9. Bethiah Mansfield^{21,22,23} (*Andrew², Robert¹*) was born 7 Apr 1658 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts²² and died 27 Jul 1720 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts^{21,23} at age 62.

Bethiah married **John Conant**,⁷⁰ son of **Lot Conant**⁵⁶ and **Elizabeth Walton**,⁴³ 7 May 1678 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁷¹ John was born 15 Dec 1652 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁵⁶ and died 30 Sep 1724 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁷² at age 71.

Children from this marriage were:

- 22 M i. **Lot Conant**^{73,74} was born about 1 Jun 1679 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,^{73,74} was christened 1 Jun 1679 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁷⁵ died 20 Sep 1767 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts^{20,74} about age 88, and was buried in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁷⁴

Noted events in his life were:

- Cemetery: South Burying Place, Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁷⁴

Lot married **Martha Cleaves**⁷⁶ 16 May 1698 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁷⁷ Martha was born about 24 Jul 1681 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁷⁸ was christened 24 Jul 1681 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁷⁸ died 15 Feb 1725 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts^{79,80} about age 43, and was buried in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: South Burying Place, Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁷⁹

Lot next married **Susanna**.

- 23 F ii. **Elizabeth Conant**⁸¹ was born 14 Jan 1681 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁸¹ and was christened 5 Feb 1682 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁸²

General Notes: An intention to marry was filed by Elizabeth Conant and Daniel Colbourn on 21 Sept 1700 in Beverly, Essex, MA. No marriage has been found in Beverly or Ipswich which is where Daniel was supposedly from.

Elizabeth married **Daniel Colbourn**⁸³ about 21 Sep 1700 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{84,85}

General Notes: A Daniel Colborne was baptized in Ipswich, Essex, on 1 Jan 1679:

Daniel, s. Thomas, Jan. 1, 1679. CTR (court record, Essex Co. Quarterly Court). This may be

- the Daniel Colbourn who filed an intention of marriage with Elizabeth Conant in 1700.
- 24 F iii. **Bethiah Conant**⁸⁶ was born 14 Oct 1684 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁸⁶ was christened 26 Oct 1684 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁸⁷ and died 4 Dec 1759⁸⁸ at age 75.

Bethiah married **Herrick Jonathan**^{89,90}.⁸⁹ Herrick was born in 1672 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹⁰ died 29 Jul 1724 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts⁹⁰ at age 52, and was buried in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁹⁰

Noted events in his life were:

- Cemetery: South Burying Place, Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁹⁰
- + 25 M iv. **John Conant**⁹¹ was born 7 Jul 1686 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹¹ was christened 15 Aug 1686 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹² and died in 1755 at age 69.
- + 26 F v. **Deborah Conant**⁹³ was born 20 Feb 1688 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁹³ and died 13 Apr 1763 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts⁹⁴ at age 75.
- 27 F vi. **Mary Conant** was born about 20 Aug 1689 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁹⁵ and was christened 20 Oct 1689 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.⁹⁶
- 28 M vii. **Daniel Conant**⁹⁷ was born 19 Nov 1694 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹⁷ was christened 25 Nov 1694 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹⁸ and died in 1751 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁹⁹ at age 57.

Daniel married **Lucy Dodge** 23 Jan 1717 in Ipswich, Essex, Massachusetts.^{100,101,102} Lucy died in 1764 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁰³

General Notes: There is a record of birth for a Lucy Dodge in Ipswich, Essex, MA: "Lucy, d. Richard, jr., at Chebacco, May 3, 1700." Chebacco Parish was at one time part of Ipswich. This is most likely the Lucy Dodge that Daniel Conant married. This Lucy Dodge would have been the sister of Martha Dodge who married Daniel Conant's brother John. Vital Records of Ipswich, Essex, MA. Vol. 1, p.120.

- 29 F viii. **Rebecca Conant**¹⁰⁴ was born 29 Mar 1696 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,¹⁰⁵ died 13 Sep 1770 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts¹⁰⁶ at age 74, and was buried in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁰⁷

General Notes: Her record of death in the Beverly Vital Records is 13 September - her gravestone says 5 September.

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Abbott Street Burial Ground, Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁰⁷

Rebecca married **Benjamin Cleaves**¹⁰⁸ 2 Jun 1719 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁰⁹ Benjamin was born about 1692 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,¹¹⁰ died about 14 Dec 1775 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts¹¹¹ about age 83, and was buried 14 Dec 1775 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{112,113}

General Notes: There is a record of death for a Benjamin Cleaves in the Vital Records of Beverly, Vol. 2, Deaths, p.400: "Benjamin, Capt., bur. Dec. 14, 1775, a. 83 y. CR1." CR1 - First Parish Unitarian Church. This is probably the Capt. Benjamin Cleaves that married Rebekah Conant.

There is a record of birth for a Benjamin Cleaves in the Vital Records of Beverly, Vol. 1, Births, p.75: "Benjamin, s. William and Margreet, Oct. 23, 1693." This would correspond to the age at burial (83) of the Capt. Benjamin Cleaves who died in 1775.

Noted events in his life were:

- Cemetery: Abbott Street Burial Ground, Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹¹³
- 30 M ix. **Benjamin Conant** was born 22 Oct 1698 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹¹⁴
- Benjamin married **Martha Davison**¹¹⁵ 24 Jan 1720 in Ipswich, Essex, Massachusetts.^{102,115}

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Marriage Intention: 25 Dec 1720, Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹¹⁶

Benjamin next married **Lydia Lamb**.

- 31 F x. **Jemima Conant**¹¹⁷ was born about 9 Nov 1701 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts¹¹⁷ and was christened 9 Nov 1701 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹¹⁸

Jemima married **John Batchelder**¹¹⁹ 6 Sep 1720 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{119,120}

12. **Deborah Mansfield**³⁰ (*Andrew*², *Robert*¹) was born 1 Jan 1667 in Lynn, Essex, Massachusetts.³⁰

General Notes: Although no record has been found of their marriage, Phillip White and Deborah Mansfield's children are listed in the Vital Records of Beverly and some of the baptisms are recorded in the First Church [Unitarian], Beverly.

Deborah married **Phillip White** in 1685.¹²¹

Children from this marriage were:

- 32 M i. **Phillip White** was born 16 Nov 1686 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹²²

Noted events in his life were:

- Baptism: Beverly, Essex, MA, 29 Jun 1690.¹²³

- 33 M ii. **John White** was born 4 Feb 1687 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹²⁴

- 34 F iii. **Deborah White** was born 26 May 1688 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹²⁵

Noted events in her life were:

- Baptism: Beverly, Essex, MA, 31 Jan 1689.¹²⁶

- 35 F iv. **Sarah White** was born about 2 Jul 1693 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{127,128}

Noted events in her life were:

- Baptism: Beverly, Essex, MA, 2 Jul 1693.¹²⁹

- 36 M v. **Andrew White**¹³⁰ was born about 9 Sep 1694 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{130,131}

Noted events in his life were:

- Baptism: Beverly, Essex, MA, 9 Sep 1694.¹³²

- 37 F vi. **Mary White** was born 6 Nov 1698 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹³³

- 38 F vii. **Mary White** was born 29 Apr 1705 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹³⁴

Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

25. John Conant⁹¹ (*Bethiah Mansfield*³, *Andrew*², *Robert*¹) was born 7 Jul 1686 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹¹ was christened 15 Aug 1686 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts,⁹² and died in 1755 at age 69.

John married **Martha Dodge**,¹³⁵ daughter of **Richard Dodge**, 30 Jan 1714 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹³⁶ Martha was born 19 May 1696 in Ipswich, Essex, Massachusetts¹³⁵ and died 5 Oct 1721 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts¹³⁸ at age 25.

Children from this marriage were:

- 39 F i. **Bethiah Conant** was born 29 Jan 1720 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹³⁹
- 40 M ii. **Samuel Conant** was born 29 Dec 1714 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁴⁰
- 41 M iii. **John Conant** was born 6 Mar 1718 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.¹⁴¹

John next married **Mary Cresey**¹⁴² 28 Jun 1722 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.^{143,144,145}

26. Deborah Conant⁹³ (*Bethiah Mansfield*³, *Andrew*², *Robert*¹) was born 20 Feb 1688 in Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts⁹³ and died 13 Apr 1763 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts⁹⁴ at age 75.

General Notes: There are baptismal records for Deborah's brothers and sisters (except Rebekah) but not for Deborah. These records were transcribed from the records of the First Church of Beverly, Essex, MA.

Deborah married **John Darby**, son of **John Darby** and **Alice**,¹⁴⁶ John was born 8 Oct 1681 in Marblehead, Essex, Massachusetts¹⁴⁷ and died 7 Mar 1753 in Concord, Middlesex, Massachusetts¹⁴⁸ at age 71.

General Notes: John Darby had 5 chn., the second of whom, John, was b. Oct. 8, 1681. This John Darby, who in his "will," 1747, spelt his name Darbie, m, Deborah, dau. ____ Conant, and located first at Beverly, but went thence to Ipswich about 1720, and from there in 1731 to Concord, where he d. In the Congregational Church records, 1714-1883, Hamilton, Massachusetts (known as the third church of Ipswich), Sarah and Benjamin Patch are listed in the church records. Andrew Darby was received into the church on 10 Dec, 1727, and he and Elizabeth Patch were married there in 1728, so this would give more weight to the possibility of Sarah and Benjamin being her parents.

In the Miscellaneous section of the Littleton Town Records there is information on the Patch family: *A copy of the Record of Benjamin Patch and his Family as taken from his own hand writing.* This notes that Benjamin was born 9 Apr 1673 and died 11 Feb 1763; that wife Sara was born 26 June 1673 and died 3 Jan 1725; that they were married 20 Oct 1697; that they had ten children, including Elizabeth, born 16 Aug 1711.
