

Descendants of Scarlet Harper and daughter Nancy Harper White

First Generation

1. **Scarlet Harper.**¹

General Notes: A pedigree resource chart at FamilySearch.org lists the parents of Scarlet Harper as George Harper and Sarah Elizabeth Shipley. Another website lists George Harper Sr, ca. 1723 VA - 1766 VA and Sarah Elizabeth Shipley, ca. 1727-? as Scarlet's parents and he is the 8th child, born ca. 1756. Some websites list the children of George Harper and Sarah Shipley but Scarlet is not included in the list of their children. George Harper, Scarlet's possible father, is said to be the brother of Sarah Harper who married Abraham Hanks, father of Nancy Hanks who was the mother of Abraham Lincoln. Ancestry.com gives his parents' names as Robert Harper and Sarah Elizabeth Shipley. So far unverified.

When Nancy Harper married Charles White, her father wrote a note citing no objections to the marriage of his daughter Nancy to Charles White. She may have been underage. His note is signed and dated 29 September 1792.

Scarlet married.

His child was:

+ 2 F i. **Nancy Harper** was born in Virginia.²

Second Generation (Children)

2. Nancy Harper (*Scarlet*¹) was born in Virginia.²

General Notes: In the Record of Marriages in Bourbon County Kentucky for the period of years 1785-1851, p.54, there is a record of marriage for Charles White and Nancy Harper, daughter of Scarlet Harper. Scarlet Harper has to sign permission in 1792 for Nancy to marry as she must have been underage.

Noted events in her life were:

- Tax Records: 1822, Montgomery County, Kentucky.³ Nancy White appears on the tax assessment for the first time, along with sons Jonathan and Joel. She continues on the assessments through 1826, usually with one or more of her sons. After 1826, none of the family appear.

Nancy married **Charles White** 2 Oct 1792 in Bourbon County, Kentucky.^{4,5} Charles was born in Virginia⁶ and died about 1821 in Montgomery County, Kentucky.⁷

General Notes: Charles White, who married Nancy Harper in 1792 in Bourbon County, Kentucky, was born in Virginia. According to various online sites, no sources, he was born in the 1770s and was in Kentucky by 1792 when he married Nancy Harper.

Their daughter Jane was born in Kentucky about 1795 according to her census records. Jane was not the only child according to the online sites. She had several brothers: Jonathan, Joel, Jedediah, and Jeremiah.

Charles is on the census for Montgomery County, KY, for 1810 and 1820. His daughter Jane's entry in the 1880 census notes that her parents were born in VA as does son Jonathan's entry.

Charles White appears on the tax lists for Kentucky in 1789 in Madison County. He is in Montgomery County, Kentucky on the 1797 tax list. He remains on the tax lists until 1822 when his name does not appear, but his wife Nancy White does, along with Jonathan White and Joel White, two of their sons. Jedediah White, another son, appears in the 1824 and 1825 lists. Mrs. Nancy White last appears in 1826. Charles probably died around 1821-22 and Nancy after 1826. On the tax assessments over the years, the water source for their properties are Harper Creek and Spencer Creek, both a bit south and east of Mt. Sterling.

Noted events in his life were:

- Tax Records: 1789, Madison County, Kentucky.⁸ First Census of Kentucky, 1790, info from 1789 tax list
- Tax Records: 1797, Montgomery County, Kentucky.⁹ Charles White, 1 white above the age of 21, and 4 horses. The tax assessments started in 1797. Kentucky was created as a state in 1792 from part of Virginia. Charles may have originally been living in the part of Virginia that became Kentucky. He was married in Bourbon Co. but then moved to Montgomery Co. which was created from Clarke Co. in 1796.
- Census: 1800, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹⁰ From tax list, date: 22 Aug 1800
- Census: 1810, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹¹ Charles White, males: 2 under 10, 2 10-16, 1 16-26, 1 26-45, 0, - females: 1 under 10, 1 10-16, 0, 1 26-45, 0 - no slaves. Charles would have been 26-45, supposedly born about 1772, he would have been about 38. Nancy, supposedly born about 1775, would have been about 35. Jane, born 1795, would have been about 15. Daughter Sarah "Sallie" supposedly born about 1802, would have been about 8. Jefferson White, supposedly born in 1810, & Jedediah White, supposedly born about 1802, would have been the 2 males under 10. Joel White, supposedly born about 1800, and Jonathan, supposedly born about 1798, would be 2 males 10-16. A son, name unknown, supposedly born about 1794, would be the 1 son 16-26.
- Census: 1820, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹² Charles White - 1 male 10-16, 1 male 16-18, 3 males 16-26, 1 male 45 and up; females: 1 under 10, 1 10-16, 1 16-26, 1 45 and up.
- Tax Records: 1821, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹³ 1821 is the last year that Charles White appears in the tax assessment records.

- Probate: 1822, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹⁴ Inventory of estate done 22 Feb 1822 and sale of items. Could not find date of administration of probate nor date of death.

Children from this marriage were:

3 M i. **Joel White.**

Noted events in his life were:

- Tax Records: 1822, Montgomery County, Kentucky.³ Joel White. Joel appears for the first and only time in 1822
- Census: 1840, Warren Township, Putnam, Indiana.¹⁵ Joel White. He is on the same census page as his brother Jonathan and Elijah Aldridge, his brother-in-law.

4 M ii. **Jedediah White.**

Noted events in his life were:

- Tax Records: 1824, Montgomery County, Kentucky.³ Jedediah White appears on the 1824 and 1825 tax lists only.

+ 5 F iii. **Jane White**¹⁶ was born in Jan 1795 in Kentucky,¹⁷ died 24 Dec 1884 in Corralitos, Santa Cruz, California^{18,19} at age 89, and was buried in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.²⁰

+ 6 M iv. **Jonathan White**²¹ was born about 1798 in Kentucky,²¹ died 20 Mar 1883 in Cloverdale, Putnam, Indiana²¹ about age 85, and was buried in Cloverdale, Putnam, Indiana.²¹

+ 7 M v. **Jeremiah White**²² was born 1 Nov 1804,²² died 20 Mar 1870²² at age 65, and was buried in Mount Sterling, Montgomery, Kentucky.²²

Third Generation (Grandchildren)

5. **Jane White**¹⁶ (*Nancy Harper*², *Scarlet*¹) was born in Jan 1795 in Kentucky,¹⁷ died 24 Dec 1884 in Corralitos, Santa Cruz, California^{18,19} at age 89, and was buried in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.²⁰

General Notes: "Jane White was born to Charles White and Nancy Harper in Clark County, Klentucky. We think she was the oldest child."

Unpublished documents: Aldridge family papers and records in the possession of Robert Aldridge, b. 1926, copy given to author, 2006.

This is the only place I have seen a county given for Jane's birth but it is very likely she was born near Mt. Sterling, then in Clark County. Clark County was created from Bourbon and Fayette counties in 1792 and Montgomery County was created from Clark County in 1796. Charles' son Jeremiah, his wife and some of their children are buried in Mt. Sterling. Mt. Sterling was originally in Bourbon County, then Clark County and then Montgomery County. So my guess is that Charles White and Nancy Harper lived near Mt. Sterling in the vicinity of Spencer and Harper Creeks, and that they were married there when it was Bourbon County, that Jane was born there while it was Clark County and that Jane was married there when it became Montgomery County.

Noted events in her life were:

- Baptism: Baptized in the Christian Church, by J. M. Mathis, 1838, Cloverdale Twshp., Putnam, Indiana.
- Census: 1850, Cloverdale Twshp., Putnam, Indiana.¹⁶ Jane Aldridge, 55, born KY, cannot read or write
- Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.²³ Jane Aldridge, 64, born KY
- Census: 1870, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.²⁴ Jane Aldridge, 75, keeping house, born KY
- Census: 1880, Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.²⁵ Jane Aldridge, 85, mother, born VA, parents born VA [altho in the same census her son Franklin says his mother was born in KY]
- Notice of Death: 1884. DIED: Near Corralitos, at the residence of her son Frank, Dec. 25th, Mrs. Jane Aldrige [sic], aged about 90 years.

Jane married **Elijah Aldridge**^{16,27} son of **Francis Aldridge** and **Margaret Cole**, 26 Jan 1812 in Kentucky.²⁸ Elijah was born 18 Feb 1792 in Rutherford County, North Carolina,^{24,29,30,31,32} died 24 May 1878 in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California³³ at age 86, and was buried 24 May 1878 in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.^{34,35}

Marriage Notes: Elijah and Jane were most likely married in Montgomery County, Kentucky. Jane's father was there from at least 1797 until 1821. Jane would have been living with her family. Elijah supposedly worked for Charles White at his brewery, so would have been living in Montgomery County.

Noted events in his life were:

- Occupation:³⁶ Worked at a brewery for Charles White in Kentucky, early 1800s
- Moved: ca. 1794.³⁷ From North Carolina to Kentucky when he was two years old.
- Tax Records: 1814, Montgomery County, Kentucky.³ Elijah Aldridge appears for the first time on the tax assessments. His water course is listed as Spencer Creek which is south and east of Mt. Sterling
- Census: 1820, Montgomery County, Kentucky.¹² Elijah Aldridge: 1 male 26-45, 3 males under 10, 1 female 16-26. Elijah's brother David is also on this page
- Census: 1830, Montgomery County, Indiana.³⁸
- Baptism: Baptized in the Christian Church, 1839, Cloverdale Twshp., Putnam, Indiana.
- Census: 1840, Warren Township, Putnam, Indiana.³⁹ Elijah Aldridge: Males: 1 under 5, 1 15-20, 1 20-30, 1 50-60; Females: 2 5-10, 1 10-15, 2 15-20, 1 40-50. On the same page, close to Elijah, are Joel White and Jonathan White, brothers of Jane White, Elijah's wife.
- Census: 1850, Cloverdale Twshp., Putnam, Indiana.¹⁶ Elijah Aldridge, 57, farmer, born NC

- Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.²³ Elijah Aldridge, 67, born NC
- Census: 1870, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.²⁴ E. Aldridge, 77, no occupation, born NC
- Moved: 1871, Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.¹⁹ Elijah's son Franklin took Jane and Elijah to California to live with him.
- Voter Registration: California Great Registers, 1876, Corralitos, Santa Cruz, California.³¹ Age 79, born NC
- Notice of Death: 1878. DIED: ALDRIDGE - In Watsonville, May 23d, Elijah Aldridge, aged 84 years

- Funeral Service: Christian Church, at 2:00 p.m., 24 May 1878, Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.⁴⁰

Children from this marriage were:

- 8 M i. **David Aldridge** was born between 1813 and 1814 in Montgomery County, Kentucky.
General Notes: In a letter from his brother Franklin A. Aldridge to their neice, Eliza Ann Whitted Bass, 11 Sept 1900, Franklin writes that David was buried in Montayuma [Montezuma], Indiana, and that he died in middle age.
David married **Jane McPherrin**⁴¹ 8 Mar 1843 in Parke County, Indiana.^{41,42}
- 9 M ii. **Hamilton Aldridge**⁴³ was born about 1818 in Montgomery County, Kentucky,⁴³ died in Iowa, and was buried in Iowa.⁴⁴
General Notes: "Hamilton married in the 1830s and was living in Owen County, Indiana in 1840."
"Hamilton died in Iowa enroute to Sacramento Valley, California by wagon train. Frank, his brother, raised his two sons, Alvin and Alonzo, who later moved to Crook County, Oregon."

- Noted events in his life were:
- State Census: 1856, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁴³ Hamilton Aldridge, 38, born KY, married; yrs resident in Iowa: 4
- Hamilton married **Lousina**.⁴³ Lousina was born circa 1820 in Kentucky.⁴³
- Noted events in her life were:
- Census: 1856, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁴³ Lousina Aldridge, 36, Born KY, yrs resident in Iowa: 4
 - Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁴⁵ Luzanee?? Aldridge, 42, farmer, born KY. She is head of household. The family is living next to the Elbridge Whitted family - Caroline Whitted was an Aldridge and Hamilton was her older brother.
- 10 M iii. **Charles Aldridge** was born about 1820 and was buried in Williamsport, Warren, Indiana.⁴⁴
General Notes: Probably born in Montgomery County, KY, as his father is listed in the 1820 census there.
- Noted events in his life were:
- Census: 1840, Warren County, Indiana.⁴⁶ Charles Aldridge
- Charles married **Mary Margaret Crider** 2 Apr 1839 in Warren County, Indiana.⁴⁷
- 11 F iv. **Caroline E. Aldridge**⁴⁸ was born 20 Apr 1822 in Montgomery County, Kentucky,^{49,50,51} died 29 Aug 1900 in Oneco, Manatee, Florida^{52,53} at age 78, and was buried in 1900 in Bradenton, Manatee, Florida.^{52,54}
General Notes: The Office of Vital Statistics, State of Florida, is unable to find a death certificate for Caroline. The microfilm of Florida death certificates, 1877-1939, at

FamilySearch.org has no certificates for several years, including 1900.

According to a letter written by Frank A. Aldridge to his niece, Eliza Ann Whitted Bass, in September 1900, Caroline's first child was born in Elijah's house in Indiana and was born dead. This child is not on the list of her children below.⁵⁵

- Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁵⁶ Caroline Whited, 30, born KY

- Census: 1885, Manatee County, Florida.⁵⁸
- Census: 1900, Tampa, Hillsborough, Florida.⁵⁹ Caroline Whitted, age 79, born KY, mother-in-law to head of household John R. Williams

- Gravestone Inscription: Whitted, Caroline E., Montgomery Co., KY, Died: 29 August, 1900, Orange Ridge, Manatee Co., Fla., Daughter of: Jane (White) and Elijah Aldridge, 1900.⁵⁴
- Cemetery: Major Adams Cemetery, 1900, Bradenton, Manatee, Florida.^{54,60} The cemetery was called New Cemetery when Caroline was buried

Caroline married **Elbridge Mabrin Whitted**,⁴⁸ son of **Jonathan Whitted**⁶² and **Nancy Rogers Clark**,⁶³ 9 May 1846 in Rockville, Parke, Indiana.⁶¹ Elbridge was born 28 Feb 1824 in Chatham County, North Carolina,^{64,65} died 6 Jan 1899 in Oneco, Manatee, Florida⁶⁶ at age 74, and was buried 7 Jan 1899 in Bradenton, Manatee, Florida.^{67,68}

General Notes: The following information is from Col. Michael and Anita Evanco:

"Elbridge departed Boone Co., IA on his trek to Florida, with his sons, ending in Manatee Co., FL. Subsequently, he had his family come by train--although he came by horseback. He stopped in Tuscaloosa Co., Alabama to visit with his sister, Nancy Caroline Kelly. He, also, was instrumental in taking care of his brother Isaac's child, Charley, who died while Elbridge was visiting with his sister.

"Elbridge arrived in Manatee County, FL and settled on land in Oneco. The Manasota Cemetery is now located on what was once Elbridge's land. Elbridge was a successful orange grower and he lived the rest of his life in Manatee County. He died at Oneco. The authors have a newspaper clipping commemorating his death. He was buried in New Cemetery (now called Major Adams Cemetery), Bradenton, Manatee Co., FL. The gravesite was unmarked when the authors found it. The authors were instrumental in having a plaque erected on the mastabas. Caroline, his wife, is lying beside Elbridge. Allen Whitted, son of Elbridge, purchased the gravesite, prepared the gravesite and personally buried Elbridge Whitted. Allen performed the same actions for his mother.

"Elbridge and Caroline (Aldridge) Whitted are located in northwest corner of the lot in New Cemetery. Allen's first wife, Allie Mae Graham, is buried in the southwest corner of the same lot. Allen performed the same service for his wife."

The Office of Vital Statistics, State of Florida, is unable to find a death certificate for Elbridge. The microfilm of Florida death certificates, 1877-1939, at FamilySearch.org has no certificates for several years, including 1899.

- Census: 1840, Parke County, Indiana.⁶⁹ Jonathan Whitted is head of household which includes 2 males 15 - 20, one of which was probably Elbridge.

- Census: 1870, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁷¹ Elbridge Whitehead, 42, farmer, born NC
- Census: State of Florida, 1885, Manatee County, Florida.⁷²
- Gravestone Inscription: Whitted, Elbridge Mabrin, Born: 28 February 1824. Chatham Co., N.C., Died: 5 January 1899, Orange Ridge, Manatee Co., Fla.. Son of: Nancy Rogers (Clark) and Jonathan Whitted, 1899.⁶⁸
- Obituary: "An Aged Citizen Dead", Jan 1899, Manatee County, Florida.⁷³ Mr. E. Whitted, an aged and honored citizen of Manatee County passed away suddenly from cerebral hemorrhage on Thursday night at the advanced age of 76 years. Mr. Whitted was a native of North Carolina, but lived several years in the West before coming to Florida about 20 years ago. Since coming to Manatee county, he had resided on Orange Ridge, about three miles south of town, surrounded by sons and daughters and their families, all of whom have nice orange groves and are prosperous. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. B. Tresca on Friday afternoon, and the body laid to rest in the Manatee Cemetery.

12 F v. **Nancy Jane Aldridge**^{75,76} was born about 1823 in Montgomery County, Kentucky,^{76,77} died 1 Sep 1885^{44,75} about age 62, and was buried in Prineville, Crook, Oregon.⁷⁵

- Census: 1850, Parke County, Indiana.⁷⁶ Nancy Aldridge, 25, born KY
- State Census: 1856, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁷⁸ Nancy Aldridge, 33, born KY, in Iowa 4 yrs
- Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁷⁹ Nancy J. Aldridge, 36, born KY
- Census: 1870, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁸⁰ Nancy J. Aldridge, 46, keeping house, born KY
- Census: 1880, Jackson County, Oregon.⁸¹ Nancy J. Aldridge, 57, born KY, parents born NC & KY
- Cemetery: 1885, Prineville, Crook, Oregon.⁷⁵ Block N, lot 67, space 4

Nancy married **Thomas Hubbard** 24 Apr 1845 in Putnam County, Indiana.⁸² Thomas was born in 1824⁸³ and died about 1848⁸³ about age 24.

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Marriage License: 24 Apr 1845, Putnam County, Indiana.⁸² Marriage license issued to Thomas Hubbard and Nancy Jane Aldridge, both of lawful age & as proven by affidavit of Franklin Aldridge..

Nancy next married **Alvin Aldridge**,^{76,81,84} son of **David Aldridge**⁸⁶ and **Rebecca Davis**,^{87,88} 25 Mar 1848 in Vermillion County, Indiana.⁸⁵ Alvin was born 13 Mar 1828 in Kentucky,^{76,81,89} died 19 May 1910 in Wilbur, Lincoln, Washington^{90,91} at age 82, and was buried in Wilbur, Lincoln, Washington.⁹⁰

General Notes: Alvin Aldridge is thought to be the son of David Aldridge and Rebecca Davis. In Aldridge Records, vol.2, by Franklin Rudolph Aldridge, the author lists the children of Elijah Aldridge and Jane White on p.226 according to research done by descendants. Hamilton, b. ca. 1823, is the 2d child listed. It notes that he *died in Iowa enroute to Sacramento Valley, California, by wagon train. Frank his brother, raised his two sons, Alvin and Alonzo, who later moved to Crook County, Oregon.* However, Alvin was born ca. 1828 and would not have been Hamilton's son. Franklin, who was born in 1825, would not have raised Alvin, born ca. 1828. In the same book, there is a letter written by Franklin Aldridge's 3d wife, Anna, in which she refers to Uncle Alvin. If Alvin was the son of David and Rebecca, he would have been Franklin's uncle. Finally, in the 1900 census his father's state of birth is NC and his mother's is KY. David was

born in NC and Rebecca in KY. I am choosing David and Rebecca as Alvin's parents - but this is unverified for now.

Find A Grave memorial for Alvin Aldridge gives his place of birth as Nebraska, but in all the census records he was born in KY. The family did not live in Nebraska. Father's name is David Aldridge, mother's name is Jane Cole - should be Rebecca Davis. Cole was his grandmother's maiden name.

- Census: 1860, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁷⁹ Alvin Aldridge 32, born KY, farmer
- Census: 1870, Dodge Twp., Boone, Iowa.⁸⁰ A. Aldridge, 42, farmer, born KY
- Census: 1880, Jackson County, Oregon.⁸¹ Alvin Aldridge, 53, farmer, born KY, father born NC, mother born KY
- Census: 1900, Crook County, Oregon.⁸⁴ Alvin Aldridge, 71, widowed, father (to head of household - son George), born Aug 1828 KY, father born NC, mother born KY, farmer, can read and write.
- Census: 1910, Columbia, Lincoln, Washington.⁹² Alin [sic] Aldridge, head, 81, widower, born KY, parents born KY
- Cemetery: Wilbur Cemetery, Wilbur, Lincoln, Washington.⁹⁰
- Obituary: 20 May 1910, Wilbur, Lincoln, Washington.⁹⁰ Death yesterday claimed a good man -- Alvin Aldridge, fther of Judge D.W. Aldridge of this city, aged 81 years 8 months 22 days.
Deceased has resided on his son's ranch 12 miles north of Wilbur. Several weeks ago he suffered a stroke of heart failur, which finally terminated into paralysis, death coming to his relief at 1:30 o'clock yesterday morning. Funeral services today at (Friday) at 1 o'clock p.m. at Christian church.
Mr. Aldridge was formerly a resident of Prineville, having spent a number of years at Bear Creek Butte where he owned considerable land.

- 13 M vi. **Franklin A. Aldridge**⁹³ was born 20 Apr 1826 in Montgomery County, Kentucky,^{93,94,95} died 23 Nov 1900 in Corralitos, Santa Cruz, California^{93,94,96} at age 74, and was buried in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, California.²⁶

General Notes: According to his obituary and a biography, Franklin taught school and farmed for five years in Indiana before marrying and moving to Illinois for a year where he also farmed and taught school. He then moved to Boone County, Iowa, where he was a township clerk and a Justice of the Peace. After three years he went with his family by wagon train to California, where he settled in Solano County and farmed for several years. He was ordained a minister of the Christian Church in 1862, acting as a part-time clergyman. Throughout his life he loved to preach.

In 1862 his wife, Elizabeth Young, died and he married his second wife, Sarah Jane Bradley, in Yolo County in 1864. In 1869 he moved his family to Pajaro Valley in Santa Cruz County where his wife died shortly after the move.

In 1871, while back in Iowa to move his parents out to California, he met and married his third wife, Anna Margaret Fallein. He managed and had an interest in flour mills in Corralitos, he was a trustee of the local school district and served in the state legislature for four years.

Martha Geneva Hansen remembers her father and the flour mill:

"My father, Franklin Aldridge, took charge of the flour mill sometime during the 1860s. He had had experience in wheat growing in Indiana and had learned to make flour. He was

also a wheat farmer in northern California after he arrived there as one of the scouts on a wagon train.

"In the making of flour my father strove for the highest quality and was proud of the brand name of his flour which was 'Golden Sheaf.' He never refused flour to anyone whether the person could pay or not. He said it was a sin to keep bread from anyone. Bread, to him, was the staff of life." The mill was later sold, became a paper mill, burned to the ground a couple years later and is now the site of the Corralitos Fire Station.
