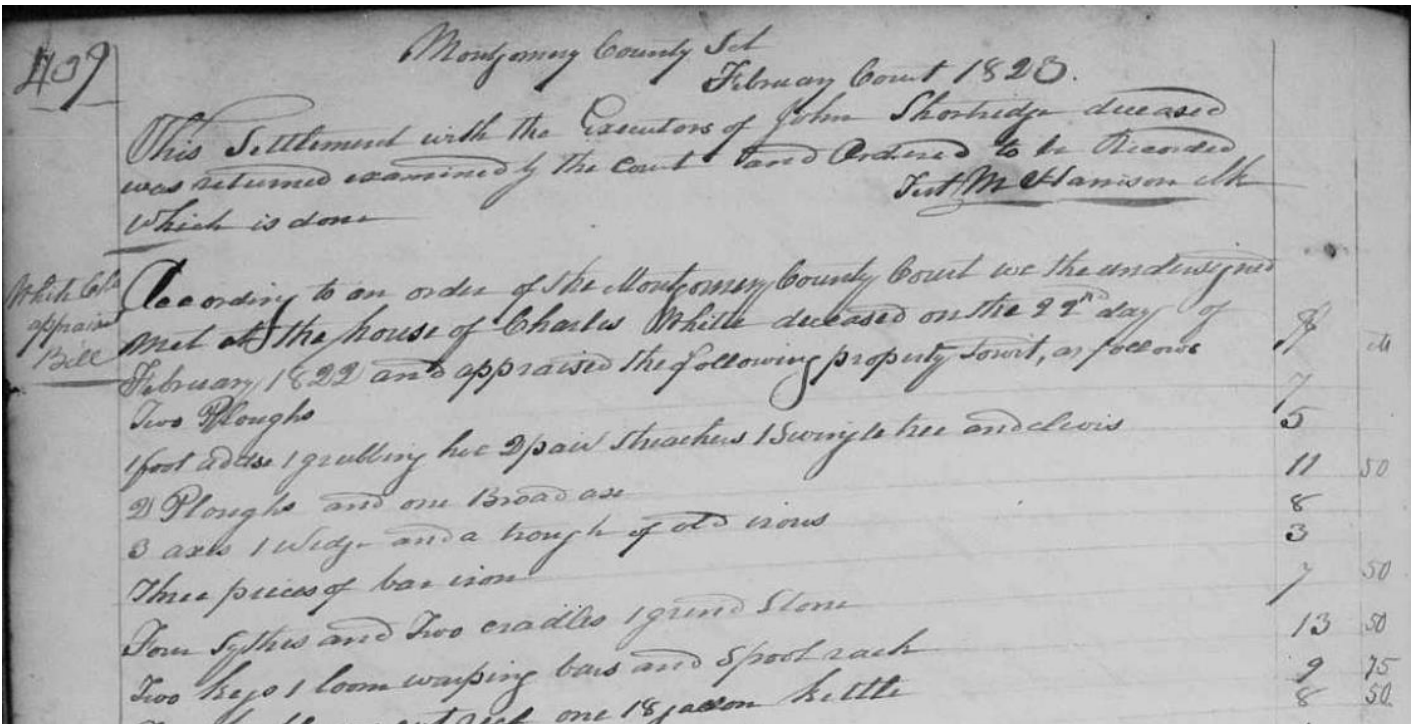

Inventory and Appraisal of Estate and Sale Bill, 1822-1823

The inventory of estate was done 22 Feb 1822, so Charles' death would have been late 1821 or very early 1822.

Only the inventory was found, begun on 22 Feb 1822, and the sale bill of the items, which included items sold to his sons Joel and Jonathan and his widow Nancy, among others. Could not find the administration of probate.

The appraisal of the estate, after the inventory, was brought before the February 1823 court, about a year after the inventory. The appraisers were Walker Chambers, Robert Evans and James Kelly.

Once the appraisal was done, the sale of the estate items took place.

pp.443-444 shows the sale bill of the estate of Charles White deceased. Among the purchasers were James Harper, possibly a brother of Nancy?, Alexander Hudson, the Jane White's brother in law, Joel and Jonathan White and Nancy White, Charles' widow. Nancy bought the bulk of the estate.
