William married **Clara Allen**,⁷ daughter of **Samuel Allen**³ and **Martha**,³ circa 1769.⁸ Clara was born circa 1754 in Essex County, Virginia³ and died before 1778.⁹

- + 14 M iii. **Williamson Gatewood** was born about 1775 in Essex County, Virginia.⁷
- 15 F iv. **Martha "Patty" Gatewood**⁷ was born circa 1776 in Essex County, Virginia⁷ and died 13 Aug 1852 in Garrard County, Kentucky⁷ about age 76.
Martha married **James Burnside**⁷ 17 Feb 1802 in Garrard County, Kentucky.⁷ James was born 9 Sep 1778 in North Carolina⁷ and died in 1861⁷ at age 83.

14. **Williamson Gatewood** (*William*³, *William*², *John*¹) was born about 1775 in Essex County, Virginia.⁷

General Notes: Williamson Gatewood was the only son of William Gatewood and Clara Allen, his three sisters being Hannah, Clara and Martha. He was mentioned in his father's will of 3 May 1782: The estate is to be kept together until Williamson reached the age of eighteen and would be under the care of his sister Amy. Besides land, William left his son his "Violen & German flute" and "all my Boks." Noted events in his life were:

- Census: 1810, Warren County, Kentucky.¹⁰ In the census as Williamson Gatewood

Williamson married **Elizabeth Hubbard**, daughter of **Ephraim Hubbard**¹⁵ and **Anne Edmonds**,¹⁶ 21 Jun 1800 in Bowling Green, Warren, Kentucky.^{7,11,12,13,14} Elizabeth was born 18 Nov 1776 in Warren County, Kentucky,¹⁷ died 8 Apr 1835 in Gallatin County, Illinois¹⁸ at age 58, and was buried in 1835 in Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.¹⁹

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Marriage Bond: 19 Jun 1800, Warren County, Kentucky.²⁰ Marriage bond of 50 pounds for intended marriage of Williamson Gatewood and Elizabeth Hubbard.
- Parental Consent to Marriage: 19 Jun 1800, Warren County, Kentucky.²¹ Consent of Ephraim Hubbard to his daughter's marriage to Williamson Gatewood.

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Westwood Cemetery, Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.²² "In Memory of Elizabeth, Consort of Williamson Gatewood, born Nov 18, 1776, died April 8, 1835

Fifth Generation (2nd Great-Grandchildren)

16. Sen. William Jefferson Gatewood²³ (*Williamson*⁴, *William*³, *William*², *John*¹) was born 6 Feb 1801 in Warren County, Kentucky,²⁴ died 8 Jan 1842 in Springfield, Sangamon, Illinois^{25,26} at age 40, and was buried in Springfield, Sangamon, Illinois.^{27,28}

General Notes: William Jefferson Gatewood was a young boy when his family moved to Franklin County, Illinois, from Kentucky. In 1823 he moved to Gallatin County, taught school and studied law. In 1828 he was admitted to the bar, moving from Shawneetown to Equality when Equality became the new county seat. He married Elewisa Hubbard, his first cousin, in 1828 and they had seven children over the years. William was elected from Gallatin County several times, serving in first the Illinois State Assembly and then in the State Senate. Being a lawyer and legislator at that time in Illinois, he knew Abraham Lincoln. He died suddenly, from a heart attack, while in Springfield, in 1842. Four of his children were still alive when he died. He was buried in the Old City Graveyard in Springfield. Later, the remains of all those in the Old City Graveyard were moved to the Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield.

Noted events in his life were:

- Census: 1830, Equality, Gallatin, Illinois.³⁰
- Property: Original Land Grant, 1832, Gallatin County, Illinois.³¹ North Fork Township (T8S R8E)
- Military Service: Black Hawk War, 1832.^{32,33} William J. Gatewood served as a Lt. Col. in Reg. 1, Brigade 1.
- Property: Original Land Grant, 1833, Gallatin County, Illinois.³⁴ Equality Township (T9S R8E)
- Census: 1840, Equality, Gallatin, Illinois.³⁵
- Public Office: Illinois.^{36,37} Served in both the Illinois State Assembly and the State Senate. Served in the General Assembly for the 7th term as a representative for Gallatin County and the 9th through 12th terms as a state senator. He died during the 12th term.
- Obituary: The Illinois Republican, 15 Jan 1842, Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.³⁸ DIED in Springfield on the 8th inst., while attending the Supreme Court the Hon. WM. JEFFERSON GATEWOOD, of this county, in the 38th year of his age. He was born in the county of Warren, State of Kentucky and came to Franklin Co., Ill. while yet a boy. About the year 1823 he came to Gallatin Co. and opened a school which continued for 2-3 years. During all this time he devoted his leisure hours to the study of law and was admitted to the bar in 1828. He has several times represented the county of Gallatin in the house of Representatives, and for two successive terms in the Senate, of which body he was a member at the time of his death. He leaves a bereaved widow and 4 little children.
- Occupation: 1828. Admitted to the bar and practiced law in Gallatin County.
- Cemetery: Oak Ridge Cemetery, Springfield, Sangamon, Illinois.^{27,28} William was buried at the Old City Graveyard and later reinterred at Oak Ridge Cemetery

William married **Elewesa A. R. Hubbard**,³⁹ daughter of **Adolphus Frederick Hubbard**, 5 Dec 1828 in Gallatin County, Illinois.^{23,40,41} Elewesa was born circa 1807 in Kentucky,^{43,44} died 21 Dec 1877 in St. Louis City, Missouri^{45,46,47,48} about age 70, and was buried in St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁴⁹

Marriage Notes: Minister was Henry F. Delany, a regularly ordained minister of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. This marriage source (Anderson) gives December 4th, 1828, not December 5th (Bender).

General Notes: In papers sent to me by Bea Whitted, wife of George Bracie Whitted, and daughter-in-law of Julia Phillips whose mother, Mary E. Phillips was the daughter of Elewisa, Elewisa's name is given as Adeline E. Rumsey. The person who wrote the notes referred to her as Grandmother Rumsey, so the writer was probably Julia herself. She notes that Jarvis Pearce married Adaline Rumsey. In Mary E. Pierce Phillips death certificate, her mother's name, Adylene Rumsey, is written over what appears to be another name but smudged out. Her name has also been given as Elewisa A.R. Gatewood. She was married first to Senator William Jefferson Gatewood (in their marriage record, December 5, 1828, she is listed as Elewisa A.R. Hubbard) and when he died she married Jarvis Pierce.

The International Genealogical Index (IGI) gives her name as Eliwisa A. Hubbard, born 2 Oct 1807 in Logan Co., KY to Robert Hubbard. Another source gives her father as Adolphus F. Hubbard and she is born in KY. Logan County is adjacent to Warren County.

Elewisa died in St. Louis, Missouri, in 1877 and her death record notes that her burial was at Friedens Cemetery. There is a Friedens Cemetery in St. Louis but the cemetery office had no record of her burial there. The original cemetery was closed at some point and the remains reinterred at the new cemetery,

so it is possible that she was buried there, just no proof.

- 19 M ii. **Col. William Jefferson Gatewood**⁵⁴ was born 10 May 1830 in Gallatin County, Illinois,^{55,56} died 26 Mar 1888 in San Diego, San Diego, California at age 57, and was buried in 1888 in San Diego, San Diego, California.^{57,58}

General Notes: William Jefferson Gatewood was a co-founder of the San Diego Union.

A request for a death certificate from the County Clerk's office in San Diego, California, turned up no record of death. Files were searched from 1 January 1883 to 31 December 1893. Source: Letter to Anne Field from Gregory J. Smith, County Clerk, San Diego County, California, 15 July 2003.

There is an Isaac J. Gatewood living with his brother Williamson J. Gatewood and wife Mary in St. Louis, MO, in the 1880 census. Both were born in Illinois and both parents were born in KY. They are the same ages as Jeff Gatewood and his brother Isaac J., sons of Elewisa & William Jefferson Gatewood of Illinois. Williamson is a river pilot. Isaac is a carpenter, married and has two children living with him, Robert and Maud. In another 1880 census he is with his wife and the two children. There are lots of Gatewoods and Williamson and Jefferson are names handed down in the family. Though this seems like they could be the same persons, Col. Jeff Gatewood and his wife Mary are in San Diego on the census on the same day. Parents of Mary in California were born in Ireland and parents of Mary in St. Louis were born in NY and MA - so two different couples.

Noted events in his life were:

- Military Service: Mexican American War, Aug 1847-Oct 1848.^{59,60,61} Bugler, Lawler's Co., Independent Mounted Volunteers (Illinois)
- Census: 1850, Sacramento, Sacramento, California.⁶² 20 years old, occupation: miner.
- Court Order: 21 Sep 1850, Gallatin County, Illinois.⁶³ Jarvis Pierce appointed guardian of the minor children of William J. Gatewood--Williamson, Ephraim H., Nancy, and Isaac I. In the 1850 census, William J. Jr. was not listed; he was in California, listed in the census as a miner.
- Property: Jun 1856, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.⁶⁴ Sold by W. Jeff Gatewood for \$700: to the San Andreas Lodge, F&AM. This is now the the OddFellows Hall on North Main St. In 1857 the Gatewoods rented rooms upstairs while the lower floor was let to various tenants.
- Political Office: District Attorney, 1856-1864, Calaveras County, California.⁶⁵
- Duel: 16 Sep 1859, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.⁶⁶ The duel took place at Moonlight Flat, south of town, between William Jefferson Gatewood and Dr. Peterson Goodwyn, after a quarrel over abolition remarks, with Goodwyn calling Gatewood a liar. Goodwyn was fatally shot and died the same day. Gatewood was exonerated.
- Tax Records: 1859-1860, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.⁶⁷ Tax assessment of \$26.40 for house and lot in San Andreas on the NE side of town, with lot of Louis on the E. Personal property: \$100 and lot \$1,000. Taxes paid 10 Apr 1860

- Census: 1860, Jenny Lind, Calaveras, California.⁶⁸ Wm. J. Gatewood, 30, lawyer, born IL, value of real estate: \$800. Nearest post office was San Andreas. Listed as living in Township No. 5 which was Jenny Lind.
- Voter Registration: 1866-1868, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.⁶⁷ Gatewood, William Jefferson, Age 36 years, attorney at law, resident San Andreas. Removed from their rolls 31 Aug 1868.
- Founded: San Diego Union newspaper, 10 Oct 1868, San Diego, San Diego, California.⁶⁹ The first edition of the paper came out on this date from a building in Old Town in San Diego. Jeff Gatewood and Edward Bushyhead were the co-founders.
- Census: 1870, San Diego, San Diego, California.⁷⁰ Jeff Gatewood, 40, lawyer, value of real estate: \$12,000, born IL
- City Directory: 1874, San Diego, San Diego, California.⁷¹ p.50: W. Jeff Gatewood, Attorney at Law, Horton's Bank Block
- Census: 1880, San Diego, San Diego, California.⁷² W. J. Gatewood, 50, married, lawyer, born IL, father born KY, mother born PA [but she was born in KY]
- Voter Registration: 1880, San Diego, San Diego, California.⁷³ W. Jeff Gatewood, age 49, born IL
- Obituary: San Diego, San Diego, California.⁷⁴ *San Diego Union*, 27 Mar 1888 "Colonel Gatewood Dead"
- Obituary: "Wife Died in 1881." Obituary is undated, name of newspaper not noted. Gatewood File, San Diego History Center, Research Library, Balboa Park, San Diego, California.
- Cemetery: Mt. Hope Cemetery, San Diego, San Diego, California.^{58,75,76} Buried in an unmarked grave, Div. 3, Sec 9, Lot 27, grave 2
- Probate: 17 Apr 1888, San Diego County, California.⁷⁷ ... the said Wm. J. Gatewood died on the day of 1888, intestate... Administration of estate given to William A. Winder (or Winden) An estate sale is to be held for "one small schooner rigged vessel now lying in the harbor of San Diego."

William married **Mary Crosthwaite**⁷⁸ 1 Oct 1857 in San Francisco, California.⁷⁹ Mary was born in 1833 in Ohio,^{80,81,82} died 27 Aug 1881 in San Diego, San Diego, California^{83,84} at age 48, and was buried in 1881 in San Diego, San Diego, California.^{57,85}

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Newspaper announcement: In S.F., Oct. 1, 1857, by Rev. Dr. Scott, W.J. Gatewood of Mokelumne Hill to Miss Mary Crosthwaite of this city.⁸⁶

Marriage Notes: p.54: GATEWOOD-CROSTHWAITE, In S.F., Oct 1, 1857, by Rev. Dr. Scott, W.J. Gatewood of Molelumne [sic] Hill to Miss Mary Crosthwaite of this city

General Notes: Death certificate does not note place of burial nor undertaker. Names of parents are unknown. Also unchecked is her marital status and sex. She was born in Ohio which agrees with the censuses. She had lived in San Diego about 10 years.

- 20 M iii. **Williamson Gatewood**⁹¹ was born about 1831 in Illinois,^{92,93} died 21 Jan 1889 in St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri⁹³ about age 58, and was buried in Colchester, McDonough, Illinois.⁹³

- Census: 1860, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁴ William Gatewood, 30, born IL, S.B. [steamboat] pilot
- City Directory: 1878, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁵ Gatewood, William, pilot, 1828 N. 11th
- Census: Jun 1880, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁶ Williamson Gatewood, 49, river pilot,

born IL, parents born KY. His brother Isaac is living with the family which includes wife Mary and son Robert and daughter Maud. Allis Day lives next door, head of household, with her son Harry, 3, and three brothers: Jno., Isaac, and Oliver.

- Census: Nov 1880, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹² Williamson Gatewood, 49, born Illinois, parents born KY, [river pilot]. Living in the household also are Alice Day, 26, a niece Alice, and her son Harry J. 3, and a grand nephew, Robert W. Gatewood. This is one of two censuses for St. Louis in 1880. Living at 1826 N. 11th St.
- City Directory: 1881, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁵ Gatewood, William, pilot, 1826 N. 11th
- City Directory: 1882, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁵ Gatewood, William, pilot, 1826 N. 11th - same address as in 1881 and same address as his brother Isaac
- City Directory: 1883, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁵ Gatewood, Williamson, pilot, 1826 N. 11th
- City Directory: 1887, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.⁹⁷ 1887 City Directory: Gatewood, Williamson, agt. Prudential Ins. Co. Res: 720 N. 15th
- Cemetery: Colchester, McDonough, Illinois.⁹³ Williamson's Death record gives his place of burial as Colchester, Illinois. There are ten cemeteries there, so there are several possibilities.

- Cemetery: Westwood Cemetery, Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.⁹⁹ Tombstone inscription: In Memory of Elizabeth Harriet, 2nd daughter of Wm. J. & Elewesa GATEWOOD... dates of birth and death are indecipherable from the photo on Find A Grave but the dates 1834-1835 are noted, as is 2nd daughter of Elizabeth Gatewood which is incorrect.

General Notes: One source says he died in 1836 in New Haven Township, Gallatin County, Illinois. However, he was alive and listed as a minor in the court proceedings that appointed Jarvis Pierce as the guardian of the Gatewood children in 1850.

In 1860 he was in San Andreas, Calaveras County, California, the same town in the Sierra foothills where his brother Jeff Gatewood was living.

Find A Grave note says died 1836 and "3d daughter of Elizabeth, but it is definitely Wm. J. and Elewesa Gatewood.

17. Ephraim H. Gatewood (*Williamson*⁴, *William*³, *William*², *John*¹) was born 7 Jul 1805 in Warren County, Kentucky²⁹ and died in 1847 in Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois at age 42.

Noted events in his life were:

- Name Fact: Lucy Rearden Bender says his name is spelled Ephriam. ¹¹² Lucy Rearden Bender says his name is spelled Ephriam.
- Property: Land Grant, New Haven Township, Gallatin County, Illinois, 1836. ¹¹³

Ephraim married **Elizabeth Ridgway** 4 Jan 1829 in Gallatin County, Illinois. ¹¹⁴

Marriage Notes: Elizabeth Ridgway [sic] is from White County. License issued 4 January 1829 by J. Caldwell, clerk, married same date by Benjamin F. Spillman OMG. Second spelling: Ridgeway. Note that Bender [Lucy] spells Ephraim "Ephriam."

General Notes: There are three Gatewoods buried in Westwood Cemetery in Shawneetown, Gallatin County: Elizabeth Gatewood, 1834-1835; Ellenor Gatewood, 1829-1834; and Mary Gatewood, 1836-1836. One or more of these could be the daughters of Elizabeth Ridgway Gatewood or Elizabeth
