- 13 F ii. **Clara Gatewood**<sup>5</sup> was born ca. 1771 in Essex County, Virginia<sup>5</sup> and died before 1850.<sup>5</sup> Clara married **John Edmondson**<sup>5</sup> 27 Dec 1792 in Essex County, Virginia.<sup>5</sup> John was born ca. 1815 in Garrard County, Kentucky.<sup>5</sup>
- + 14 M iii. **Williamson Gatewood** was born ca. 1775 in Essex County, Virginia.<sup>5</sup> Williamson married **Elizabeth Hubbard** (d. 8 Apr 1835) 21 Jun 1800 in Warren County, Kentucky.<sup>5,10,11</sup>
- 15 F iv. **Martha "Patty" Gatewood**<sup>5</sup> was born ca. 1776 in Essex County, Virginia<sup>5</sup> and died 13 Aug 1852 in Garrard County, Kentucky<sup>5</sup> about age 76. Martha married **James Burnside**<sup>5</sup> 17 Feb 1802 in Garrard County, Kentucky.<sup>5</sup> James was born 9 Sep 1778 in North Carolina<sup>5</sup> and died in 1861<sup>5</sup> at age 83.

Williamson married **Elizabeth Hubbard**, daughter of **Ephraim Hubbard** and **Anne Edmonds**, 21 Jun 1800 in Warren County, Kentucky.<sup>5,10,11</sup> Elizabeth was born 18 Nov 1776 in Warren County, Kentucky,<sup>13</sup> died 8 Apr 1835 in Gallatin County, Illinois<sup>14</sup> at age 58, and was buried in 1835 in Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.<sup>15</sup>

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Westwood Cemetery, Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.<sup>16</sup> "In Memory of Elizabeth, Consort of Williamson Gatewood, born Nov 18, 1776, died April 8, 1835

+ 17 M ii. **Ephraim H. Gatewood** was born 7 Jul 1805 in Warren County, Kentucky<sup>23</sup> and died in 1847 in Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois at age 42.

Ephraim married **Elizabeth Ridgway** 4 Jan 1829 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>24</sup>

16. **William Jefferson Gatewood**<sup>17</sup> (*Williamson*<sup>4</sup>, *William*<sup>3</sup>, *William*<sup>2</sup>, *John*<sup>1</sup>) was born 6 Feb 1801 in Warren County, Kentucky<sup>18</sup> and died 8 Jan 1842 in Springfield, Illinois<sup>19</sup> at age 40.

Noted events in his life were:

- Property: Original Land Grant, 1832, Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>25</sup> North Fork Township (T8S R8E)
- Property: Original Land Grant, 1833, Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>26</sup> Equality Township (T9S R8E)
- Obituary: The Illinois Republican, 15 Jan 1842, Shawneetown, Gallatin, Illinois.<sup>27</sup> *DIED in Springfield on the 8th inst., while attending the Supreme Court the Hon. WM. JEFFERSON GATEWOOD, of this county, in the 38th year of his age. He was born in the county of Warren, State of Kentucky and came to Franklin Co., Ill. while yet a boy. About the year 1823 he came to Gallatin Co. and opened a school which continued for 2-3 years. During all this time he devoted his leisure hours to the study of law and was admitted to the bar in 1828. He has several times represented the county of Gallatin in the house of Representatives, and for two successive terms in the Senate, of which body he was a member at the time of his death. He leaves a bereaved widow and 4 little children.*

William married **Elewisa A. R. Hubbard**,<sup>20</sup> daughter of **Adolphus Frederick Hubbard** and **Unknown**, 5 Dec 1828 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>17,21,22</sup> Elewisa was born ca. 1807 in Kentucky,<sup>28,29</sup> died 21 Dec 1877 in St. Louis City, Missouri<sup>30,31,32</sup> about age 70, and was buried in St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.

Marriage Notes: Minister was Henry F. Delany, a regularly ordained minister of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. This marriage source (Anderson) gives December 4th, 1828, not December 5th (Bender).

General Notes: In papers sent to me by Bea Whitted, wife of George Bracie Whitted, and daughter-in-law of Julia Phillips whose mother, Mary E. Phillips was the daughter of Elewisa, Elewisa's name is given as Adeline E. Rumsey. The person who wrote the notes referred to her as Grandmother Rumsey, so the writer was probably Julia herself. She notes that Jarvis Pearce married Adaline Rumsey. In Mary E. Pierce Phillips death certificate, her mother's name, Adylene Rumsey, is written over what appears to be another name but smudged out. Her name has also been given as Elewisa A.R. Gatewood. She was married first to Senator William Jefferson Gatewood (in their marriage record, December 5, 1828,

she is listed as Elewisa A.R. Hubbard) and when he died she married Jarvis Pierce.

The International Genealogical Index (IGI) gives her name as Eliwisa A. Hubbard, born 2 Oct 1807 in Logan Co., KY to Robert Hubbard. Another source gives her father as Adolphus F. Hubbard and she is born in KY. Logan County is adjacent to Warren County.

- Census: 1860, Harrisburg, Saline, Illinois.<sup>34</sup>
- Census: 1870, Indian Creek, White, Illinois.<sup>35</sup> Louisa Gatewood, 65, born Illinois. Living with her daughter Nancy Addison and family
- Cemetery: Freidens Cemetery, 1877, St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri.<sup>36</sup> Cemetery is located at 8941 N. Broadway, St. Louis, MO 63137

- 19 M ii. **Col. Williamson Jefferson Gatewood**<sup>37</sup> was born 10 May 1830 in Gallatin County, Illinois<sup>38,39</sup> and died 26 Mar 1888 in San Diego, San Diego, California at age 57.

General Notes: William Jefferson Gatewood was a co-founder of the San Diego Union.

A request for a death certificate from the County Clerk's office in San Diego, California, turned up no record of death. Files were searched from 1 January 1883 to 31 December 1893. Source: Letter to Anne Field from Gregory J. Smith, County Clerk, San Diego County, California, 15 July 2003.

- Occupation: Miner, 1850, Sacramento, Sacramento, California.<sup>40</sup>
- Census: 1860, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.<sup>42</sup> Wm. J. Gatewood, 30, lawyer, born IL, value of real estate: \$800
- Occupation: Lawyer, 1860, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.<sup>43</sup>
- Census: 1870, San Diego, San Diego, California.<sup>44</sup> Jeff Gatewood, 40, lawyer, value of real estate: \$12,000, born IL
- Occupation: Lawyer, 1870, San Diego, San Diego, California.<sup>44</sup>
- Census: 1880, San Diego, San Diego, California.<sup>45</sup> W. J. Gatewood, 50, married, lawyer, born IL, father born KY, mother born PA [but she was born in KY]
- Political Office: District Attorney, 1856-1864, Calaveras County, California.<sup>46</sup>

Williamson married **Mary Crosthwaite**<sup>47</sup> 1 Oct 1857 in San Francisco, California.<sup>48</sup> Mary was born in 1833 in Ohio<sup>43,49,50</sup> and died 27 Aug 1881 in San Diego, San Diego, California<sup>51,52</sup> at age 48.

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Newspaper announcement: In S.F., Oct. 1, 1857, by Rev. Dr. Scott, W.J. Gatewood of Mokelumne Hill to Miss Mary Crosthwaite of this city.<sup>53</sup>

Marriage Notes: Another record says he married Mary Keltean 24 May 1859 in St. Louis Missouri.

General Notes: Death certificate does not note place of burial nor undertaker. Names of parents are unknown. Also unchecked is her marital status and sex. She was born in Ohio

which agrees with the censuses. She had lived in San Diego about 10 years.

Gallatin County Illinois, Marriages, Book "B" 1867 to 1874, Book "C" 1874 to 1882, Book "D" 1882 to 1887. Transcribed by Betty Head, Saline County Genealogical Society, 1995.

There is a marriage listed in the Brides Index for an Elizabeth Gatewood and William Dickson, August 6, 1854, Marriage Book 2, p.198.

- 21 M iv. **Ephraim H. Gatewood**<sup>55</sup> was born 4 Sep 1836 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>56,57</sup>

General Notes: One source says he died in 1836 in New Haven Township, Gallatin County, Illinois. However, he was alive and listed as a minor in the court proceedings that appointed Jarvis Pierce as the guardian of the Gatewood children in 1850.

In 1860 he was in San Andreas, Calaveras County, California, the same town in the Sierra foothills where his brother Jeff Gatewood was living.

Noted events in his life were:

- Court Order: 21 Sep 1850, Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>41</sup> Jarvis Pierce appointed guardian of the minor children of William J. Gatewood---Williamson, Ephraim H., Nancy, and Isaac I.
- Occupation: Steam engineer, 1860.<sup>58</sup>
- Census: 1860, San Andreas, Calaveras, California.<sup>58</sup> Ephraim H. Gatewood, 25, steam engineer, born IL

- 22 F v. **Mary Gatewood** was born 4 Nov 1836.

- + 23 F vi. **Nancy V. Gatewood**<sup>59</sup> was born about 1837 in Gallatin County, Illinois.

Nancy married **Sidney Addison**<sup>35</sup> 4 Aug 1852 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>60</sup>

- 24 M vii. **Isaac J. Gatewood**<sup>61</sup> was born about 1840.

General Notes: There is an Isaac J. Gatewood in the 1880 census, living in St. Louis, St. Louis, MO, age 43, a carpenter, married to either Ellen or Miller [2 different transcriptions] and with two children: Robert 6 and Maude 3, both born Missouri. They would have been living in Missouri about 1877 when Isaac's mother Elewisa died in St. Louis. She might have been living with them.

- Name Fact: Lucy Rearden Bender says his name is spelled Ephriam.
- Property: Land Grant, New Haven Township, Gallatin County, Illinois, 1836.<sup>62</sup>

Ephraim married **Elizabeth Ridgway** 4 Jan 1829 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>24</sup>

Marriage Notes: Elizabeth Ridgway [sic] is from White County. License issued 4 January 1829 by J. Caldwell, clerk, married same date by Benjamin F. Spillman OMG. Second spelling: Ridgeway. Note that Bender [Lucy] spells Ephraim "Ephriam."

Nancy married **Sidney Addison**<sup>35</sup> 4 Aug 1852 in Gallatin County, Illinois.<sup>60</sup> Sidney was born ca. 1820 in Illinois.<sup>35</sup>

General Notes: S. probably stands for Sydney or Sidney as he went by Sydney in the 1870 census and Sidney in the 1860 census. A marriage record indexed him as Larcedeny S. Addison. Other records have him as Sir Sidney Addison.
