This John must have died because there was another John born to Thomas Hope and Mary Leonard in 1870.

Catherine Furlong Hope has this John married to Mary Leonard of the Hollow, but I think it was the next John in the family that married her. This was the second John born in this family. The first one must have died.

In 1910 census, his age is given as 36 which would put his birth date at 1874. Baptismal date is a better source.

In 1910, Anthony's mother-in-law is living with them in Scranton. She is Ellen Leonard, age 75, born Ireland.

In 1920 the family is living at 210 Prospect Ave., Scranton.

Both of them emigrated before 1900 but could not find them in 1900 census in Scranton.

In 1923 & 1924 could not find them in the Scranton City Directory.
