He married **Mary Barrett⁸** ca. 1829 in County Mayo, Ireland⁹. She was born 1789 in County Mayo, Ireland¹⁰, and died 10 Mar 1875 in Dervin, County Mayo, Ireland^{10,11,12}.

Notes for Thomas Hope:

His death certificate indicates that he was a pensioner at the time of his death.

Description: 31 Jul 1827, 5'4", with grey eyes, fair complexion and brown hair^{14,15}

- 4 iii. Mary Hope²⁷, born ca. 1834 in Dervin, County Mayo, Ireland^{28,29}; died 24 Jul 1898 in St. Paul, Ramsey, Minnesota^{30,31}. She married Patrick M. Healy³² 30 Nov 1854 in Addergoole Parish, County Mayo, Ireland³³; born Mar 1826 in Derafadda, County Mayo, Ireland^{34,35,36}; died 20 Jun 1906 in St. Paul, Ramsey, Minnesota^{37,38}.

Notes for Mary Hope:

Mary Hope Healy's birth date is questionable. On her gravestone, her year of birth is 1831 on her gravestone. At her death in 1898, her age is 62, making her birth about 1836. In the passenger manifest on the S.S. England in 1866, she is 34, putting her birth about 1832. In the 1875 state census she is 37, putting her birth about 1838. If she was born in 1831, she would have been 23 when she married. If born in 1838, she would have been 16.

Notes for Patrick M. Healy:

Patrick Healy and Mary Hope and their four children, Patrick 9, Thomas, 6, Bridget, 4, and Mary, 2, left Collarua, Co. Mayo, Ireland, for America in 1866. They boarded the S.S. England in Queenstown on the evening of March 29 bound for New York City. A cholera epidemic broke out while en route and the ship was diverted to McNabs Island, near Halifax, in Canada. Mary, the youngest, died and was buried at sea. Passengers were quarantined on McNabs Island until May, when they were cleared for entry into New York. From there, the family travelled by train to Minnesota where other family members had settled. The family eventually settled in Faribault and later moved to Saint Paul.
