There is a record dated 7 August 1802: "Marriage of Estanislav Le Baisseur, native of Quebec, son of Noel Le Baisseur and Ynes LaJeu, natives of neighborhood (?) of Quebec in Canada, and Elisabetha Vigno, native of Detroit, daughter of _____ (sic)." This is probably Stanislas le Vasseur.

2. **Etienne² le Vasseur** (Estanislav¹)²¹ was born in Quebec, Canada²¹. He married **(1) Marie LaRose²²** 15 Oct 1792 in Arkansas Post, Arkansas²². He married **(2) Louise Jardelat²³** 16 Apr 1798 in Arkansas Post, Arkansas²⁴, daughter of Pierre Jardelat and Marie Languedoc. She was born in Arkansas Post, Arkansas.

Notes for Etienne le Vasseur:

Etienne married Marie LaRose in 1792 but in the 1793 census she is listed under Estanislav Vasseur as his wife. They have one child. I think this is a mistake and Estanislav is Etienne. In the 1791 census Etienne is listed with Marie, his wife, and they are living with his father, Estanislav, and his brother, Francois. Never, in any of the censuses, are Etienne and Estanislav (Jr.) ever mentioned together. I

don't know if it was written down wrong originally or transcribed wrong, but my guess is that Estanislao (son of Estanislao) and Etienne are the same person, and that Marie LaRose was married to Etienne.

Etienne is also referred to as Etienne Victoire. In October 1792, Etienne Victoire Le Vasseur is Godfather to a child at a baptism. At the marriage of his sister Therese in 1792, he is listed with his brother Francois as Etienne Victor.

The paternal grandparents are Estanislaus Vasseur and Teresa Deloeil, natives of Montreal in Canada; the maternal, Pedro Jardelat and Maria Langedoc, natives of Louisiana. On that child I performed the sacred ceremonies and prayers, and I put for a name Delfina. Her godparents were Josef Peynes [Reynes] and Margarita Granper, to whom I advised of the spiritual kinship, and so that it might be certain, I signed it.

3. Charlotte² le Vasseur (Estanislas¹)⁵⁰ was born ca. 1763 in Quebec, Canada⁵¹, and died 16 Mar 1799 in Arkansas Post, Arkansas⁵². She married **(1) Antonio Bauvais**^{53,54}. He was born ca. 1731 in Kaskaskia, Illinois, New France⁵⁵, and died 12 Jul 1794 in Arkansas Post, Arkansas⁵⁶. She married **(2) Pedro Burel**⁵⁷ 25 Oct 1798 in Arkansas Post, Arkansas⁵⁸, son of Joseph Burel and Elisabetha Bienvenu. He was born in Varenne, Canada⁵⁹.

Notes for Charlotte le Vasseur:

Charlotte goes by more than one name. Charlotte, Carolina, Charlota, and Charolette. Language and transcription is one reason, but why she is Charlotte and then Carolina is not known unless she was Charlotte Caroline. There is no one record which identifies her by both names. In the 1791 census she is Charlotte, the wife of Antoine Bauvay; in 1793 she is Charlotte Vasseur, wife of Antoine Beauvay; in the record of her marriage in 1798 she is Carolina le Vasseur, widow of Antonio Bauvais, daughter of Stanislas le Vasseur; so Charlotte and Carolina are the same person.

In the census taken at the Post of Arkansas in 1793, Antoine Beauvay and his wife Charlotte Vasseur, and six children are listed. At the time of her marriage to Pedro Burel, she is Carolina le Vasseur, widow of Antonio Bauvais. At her burial, she is Charlota Vasseur, wife of Pedro Burel. In the 1791 census, she is Charlotte, wife of Antoine Bauvay.

Charlotte married Pedro Burel 25 Oct 1798. In the census, taken 2 December 1798, Pedro Burel is listed in the census as Pedro Burelle with Juana Burelle, his wife, and two children, Jose Bauvais and Luis Bauvais. Pedro is over 49 years of age (he was over 49 in 1796 but not in 1794). Charlotte is not listed in the census, but two of her children were: Jose Bauvais and Luis Bauvais. It is not known if Juana is Charlotte using another name or why Pedro is married to Charlotte in October and in the census six weeks later with a wife named Juana. It might be possible that there is more than one Pedro Burel, but two of Charlotte's children are living with him. She died a few months later, age 36. Pedro was over 49.

Antoine Ste. Jemme dit Bauvais is the name given in one of the records of his burial. In a record of baptism for his son Michel, his name is recorded as Antoine Ste. Gemme Beauvais. The "dit" in the name above means that he went by the name St. Jemme (or Ste. Gemme), but also Bauvais. Many French took new names in New France.

*A note at the bottom says that no surname was given for Elizabeth because, possibly, she was an Indian; however, the marriage record of Joseph Dardenne in French lists his mother as "Louise", a Padoucas Indian (that is, Comanche).
