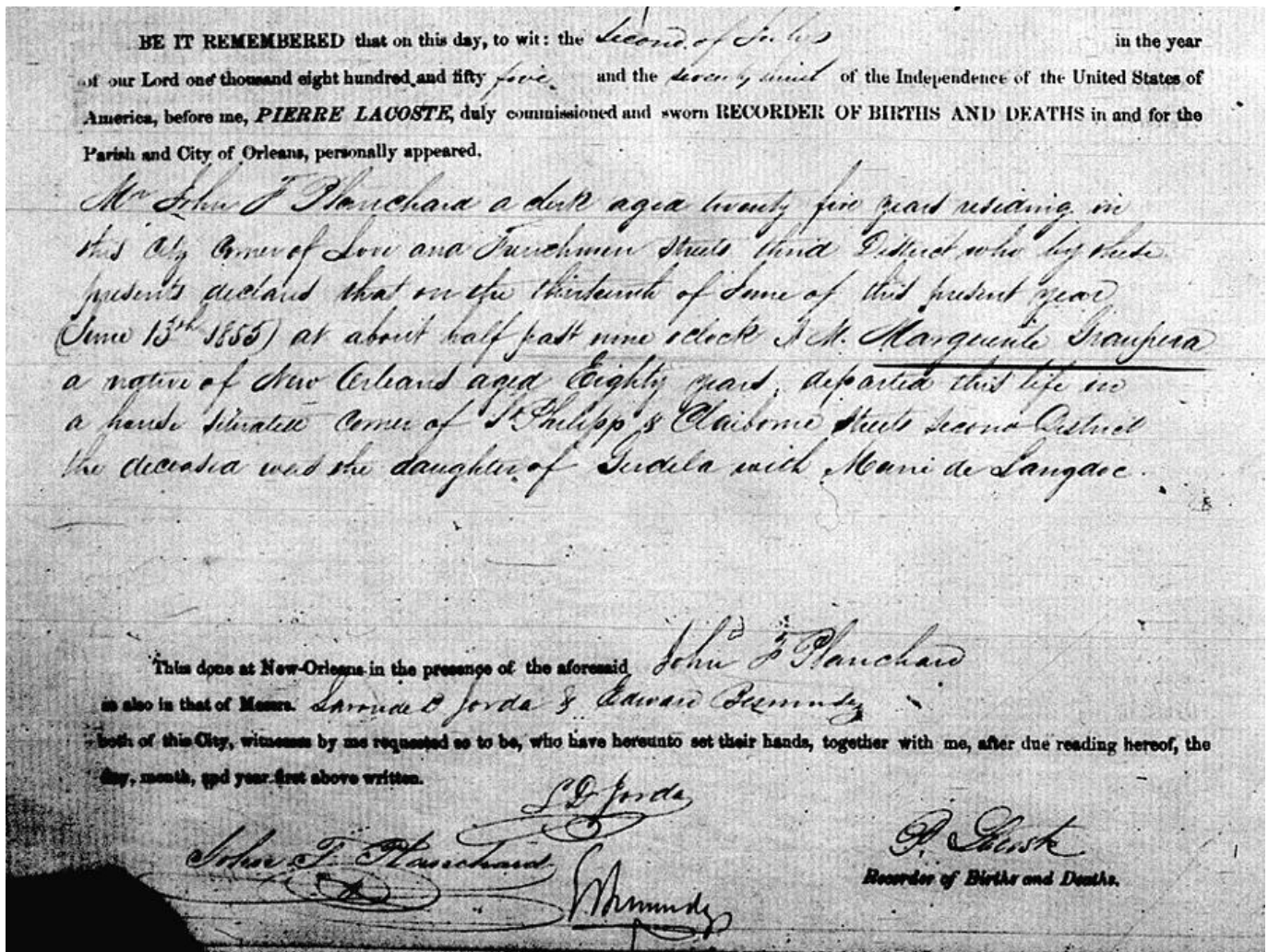


Record of death: Marguerite Granpera, 13 June 1855, New Orleans

Marguerite Jardelat Granpera was the eighth child of Pierre Jardelat and Marie Languedoc [or Songy], born in 1781 at the Post of the Arkansas where her family lived. She married Pablo Granpera in 1799.

Be it remembered that on this day, to wit: the Second of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifty five and the seventy third of the Independence of the United States of America, before me Pierre Lacoste, duly commissioned and sworn Recorder of Births and Deaths in and for the Parish and City of Orleans, personally appeared,

Mr. John F. Planchard a clerk aged twenty five years residing in this city corner of Love and Frenchman Streets third District who by these presents declared that on the thirteenth of June

of the present year (June 13th 1855) at about half past nine o'clock a.m. Marguerite Granpera, a native of New Orleans aged eighty years departed this life in a house situated corner of Philipp & Claiborne Streets Second District. the deceased was the daughter of Gerdela with Marie de Langdoc.

This done at New-Orleans in the presence of the aforesaid John F. Planchard and also in that of Messrs. Sarude D. Jorda & Edward Resendez both of this city, witnesses by me, requested so to be, who have hereunto set their hands, together with me, after due reading hereof, the day, month and year first above written.
