Thomas married **Mary Baker**.<sup>1,2</sup> Mary was born in 1666 in England<sup>2</sup> and died in 1714<sup>2</sup> at age 48.

General Notes: The Find A Grave website gives a death year of 1777, while the History of Frederick County, Maryland, Vol. 1, by Folger McKinsey & T.J.C. Williams, and a DAR record gives a death date of 1771.

Noted events in his life were:

- Cemetery: Brewhouse Property Cemetery, Wallville, Calvert, Maryland.<sup>2</sup>

Thomas married **Dorcas Sedwick**,<sup>3,6</sup> daughter of **Joshua Sedwick**<sup>1</sup> and **Elizabeth**,<sup>1</sup> 12 Mar 1725.<sup>7</sup> Dorcas was born 2 Nov 1705,<sup>1,4</sup> died 11 Dec 1770<sup>1,4</sup> at age 65, and was buried in Wallville, Calvert, Maryland.<sup>8</sup>

Marriage Notes: Another source (DAR #29156) gives marriage date as 13 March, not 12 March.

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Brewhouse Property Cemetery, Wallville, Calvert, Maryland.<sup>8</sup>

Children from this marriage were:

General Notes: Died young.

Benjamin married **Sarah**.<sup>11</sup>

Benjamin next married **Catherine Bull**.

+ 5 F iii. **Mary Johnson**<sup>1,4</sup> was born 5 May 1729 in Wallville, Calvert, Maryland<sup>4,12,13</sup> and died in Dec 1801 in Calvert County, Maryland<sup>13</sup> at age 72.

Mary married **Walter Hellen Sr.**<sup>4,13</sup> (b. Abt 1726, d. 1775)

6 F iv. **Rebecca Johnson**<sup>1,4,14</sup> was born 3 Nov 1730,<sup>1,4,14</sup> died 11 Mar 1767<sup>4,14</sup> at age 36, and was buried in Wallville, Calvert, Maryland.<sup>14</sup>

General Notes: Rebecca's gravestone gives a death date of 11 March 1767. A DAR source says 1 March. The gravestone looks new, like someone put it up more recently than when she died.

Rebecca died soon after her marriage.

Rebecca married **Thomas McKenzie**.<sup>4</sup>

7 M v. **Thomas Johnson**<sup>15,16</sup> was born 4 Nov 1732 in St. Leonard's Creek, Calvert, Maryland,<sup>1,15,16,17</sup> died 26 Oct 1819 in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland<sup>1,16,17,18</sup> at age 86, and was buried in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>16</sup>

Noted events in his life were:

- Occupation: 1760s.<sup>19</sup> Admitted to the Frederick County Bar after studying law under Thomas Jennings In Annapolis.
- Military Service: Served as Brigadier General in in the Maryland militia.
- Political Activity: Delegate, Continental Congress, 1774-1777.<sup>17</sup>
- Political Office: 1777-1780, Maryland.<sup>17</sup> Elected governor by the state legislature, 1st governor of Maryland
- Political Activity: Associate Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court, 1779-1793.<sup>20</sup>
- Residence: Abt 1780.<sup>20</sup> After serving as governor of Maryland, Thomas and family moved to an estate called *Richfield* where Thomas built a new home.
- Political Activity: 22 Jan 1791, Washington, D.C.<sup>21</sup> Appointed by George Washington to

- serve as one of the three on the Board of Commissioners to lay out the federal capital
- Death Fact: 26 Oct 1819, Frederick County, Maryland.<sup>20</sup> Died at the home of his daughter, *Rose Hill Manor*, in Frederick, Maryland.
- Notice of Death: 18 Nov 1819, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>22,23</sup> *Johnson, Thomas -- Died on Tuesday morning, the 26th ult., at Rose Hill, the seat of John Grahame, near the close of his 87th year the venerable patriot, Thomas Johnson, a native of Calvert Co., in this State, and for the last forty years of his life a resident in this county [Frederick]. He was the first Governor of the State after the declaration of Independence. His body was interred in the family vault in the Episcopal burial ground of this city [Frederick-Town].*
- Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>16,22</sup> Area MM, lot 38

Thomas Johnson was originally buried in the All Saints Episcopal Graveyard in Frederick, Md. After locating his burial place, the remains of those buried in this graveyard were moved to Mount Olivet Cemetery.

Thomas married **Anne Jennings**,<sup>15,20</sup> daughter of **Thomas Jennings** and **Rebecca Sauders**,<sup>20</sup> 16 Feb 1766.<sup>24,25</sup> Anne was born 8 May 1745 in Annapolis, Anne Arundel, Maryland,<sup>20</sup> died 22 Nov 1794 in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland<sup>19,20</sup> at age 49, and was buried in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>20</sup>

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>20</sup> MM, 38-2
- 8 F vi. **Dorcas Johnson**<sup>15</sup> was born 7 Oct 1734<sup>4,26</sup> and died 8 Dec 1809<sup>3</sup> at age 75.  
Dorcas married **Col. Josiah Clapham**.<sup>15,27</sup>
- 9 M vii. **Col. James Johnson**<sup>1,4,15,28</sup> was born 30 Sep 1736,<sup>1,4,15,28</sup> died 3 Dec 1809<sup>15,28</sup> at age 73, and was buried in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>28</sup>

General Notes: Settled in Frederick County.

Another source has Mary Skinner Belt marrying Robert Johnson, son of James Johnson, 1736-1809 (brother of Benjamin) and Margaret Skinner, 1749-1803. This source has Margaret and Col. James first son John born 1761. Margaret would have been twelve when he was born and fifteen when Robert was born. This is a bit of a stretch. My DAR source has Mary Skinner Belt's parents as Robert, son of Benjamin, b.1727, and Benjamin's second wife, Catherine Bull.

Noted events in her life were:

- Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>29</sup>
- 10 F viii. **Elizabeth Johnson**<sup>1,4,15</sup> was born 17 Sep 1739<sup>1,4,15</sup> and died 22 Nov 1818<sup>15</sup> at age 79.  
Elizabeth married **Capt. George Cook**.<sup>4,15</sup>

Noted events in his life were:

- Military Service:<sup>1</sup> George served as captain of the Maryland war vessel *Enterprise* during the American Revolution

Noted events in his life were:
- Military Service:<sup>4</sup> Served as a surgeon in the Maryland Line during the American Revolution
- John married someone.
- Marriage Notes: Married Mrs. Sharp of Loudon County, VA<sup>15</sup>
- 13 M xi. **Col Baker Johnson**<sup>1,15,35</sup> was born 30 Sep 1747 in Calvert County, Maryland,<sup>1,4,15,35</sup> died 18 Jun 1811 in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland<sup>15,35</sup> at age 63, and was buried in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>35</sup>
- Noted events in his life were:
- Military Service:<sup>4,35</sup> Commanded a battalion with the rank of Colonel in the brigade of his brother Col. James Johnson during the American Revolution. Fought at the Battle of Paoli near what is now Malvern, PA.
  - Occupation: Frederick County, Maryland.<sup>35</sup> Practiced law, later becoming a leading member of the bar of Frederick and of the General Court.
  - Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>35</sup> Originally buried elsewhere and then reinterred in Mt. Olivet Cemetery.
- Baker married **Catharine Griffith "Kitty" Worthington**,<sup>4,15,36</sup> daughter of **Col. Nicholas Greenberry Worthington**<sup>4,36</sup> and **Catharine**,<sup>36</sup> 9 Dec 1784.<sup>15</sup> Catharine was born 27 Oct 1761 in Anne Arundel County, Maryland,<sup>36</sup> died 9 Jun 1814 in Frederick County, Maryland<sup>36</sup> at age 52, and was buried in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>36</sup>
- Noted events in her life were:
- Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>36</sup> Catharine was reinterred in Mt. Olivet from an unknown original burial site.
- 14 M xii. **Maj Roger Johnson**<sup>1,4,15,37</sup> was born 18 Mar 1748 in Calvert County, Maryland<sup>4,15,37,38</sup> and died 3 Mar 1831 in Frederick County, Maryland<sup>15,37</sup> at age 82.
- General Notes: Roger may have been born on March 15 or March 18
- Noted events in his life were:
- Military Service:<sup>4,37</sup> Served as Major in his brother James's Battalion during the American Revolution
- Roger married **Elizabeth "Betsy" Thomas**,<sup>4,15,39</sup> daughter of **Richard Thomas**<sup>4,39</sup> and **Sarah Coale**,<sup>39</sup> 4 Feb 1781 in Frederick Town, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>15,37</sup> Elizabeth was born 28 Oct 1755 in Montgomery County, Maryland<sup>39</sup> and died 7 Sep 1837 in Frederick, Frederick, Maryland<sup>39</sup> at age 81.

4. **Benjamin Johnson**<sup>3</sup> (*Thomas II*<sup>2</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>1</sup>) was born 6 Jul 1727 in St. Leonard's Creek, Calvert, Maryland<sup>3,10</sup> and died 17 May 1785<sup>3,10</sup> at age 57.

General Notes: Benjamin was married twice. His first wife was Sarah, last name unknown but some sources say Backus. The second wife was Catherine Bull, sometimes wrongly named as the wife of his son, Thomas Johnson Jr.

Noted events in his life were:

- Military Service:<sup>4</sup> Major, Maryland Forces, during the American Revolution, serving in his brother Thomas's regiment

Benjamin married **Sarah**.<sup>11</sup>

Marriage Notes: In a DAR magazine article, the author notes that Benjamin's first wife was a Hellen, and his second wife a Backus.

General Notes: One source gives her middle name as Baker.

Mary married **Walter Hellen Sr.**<sup>4,13</sup> Walter was born about 1726<sup>13</sup> and died in 1775<sup>13</sup> about age 49.

- 23 M i. **Walter Hellen Jr**<sup>45</sup> was born in 1766 in Calvert County, Maryland,<sup>45</sup> died 30 Oct 1815 in Washington, D.C.<sup>45</sup> at age 49, and was buried in Washington, D.C..<sup>45</sup>

- Cemetery: Rock Creek Cemetery, Washington, D.C.<sup>45</sup> Section A, Plot 13, subplot 11

General Notes: The Life of Thomas Johnson, by Edward S. Deplaine, gives Joshua's birth year as 1742.

- Military Service:<sup>1</sup> Served as an agent in France during the American Revolution
- Cemetery: Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Frederick, Maryland.<sup>31</sup>
- Occupation: 1785-1799, London, England.<sup>1</sup> United States consul in London

Joshua married **Catherine Nuth**<sup>15,32</sup> Catherine was born in 1757 in London, England,<sup>32</sup> died 29 Oct 1811 in Washington, D.C.<sup>32</sup> at age 54, and was buried in Washington, D.C..<sup>32</sup>

General Notes: Of Nantes, France<sup>15</sup>

Children from this marriage were:

Quincy Adams, Esquire, Ambassador from the United States of America to the Court of Berlin and the son of John Adams President of the United States, to Miss Louisa Johnson, second daughter of Joshua Johnson, Edquire, of Great Tower Hill."

General Notes: Place and year of birth are uncertain, possibly London, England, or Nantes, France.

## Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

**15. Thomas Baker Johnson Jr.**<sup>3,40</sup> (*Benjamin*<sup>3</sup>, *Thomas II*<sup>2</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1753 in Annapolis, Anne Arundel, Maryland<sup>3</sup> and died in Dec 1795 in Washington, D.C.<sup>3,41</sup> at age 42.

General Notes: Thomas Baker Johnson, Jr., who went by Thomas Johnson Jr., was the son of Benjamin Johnson and the grandson of Thomas Johnson and Dorcas Sedwick of Maryland. Thomas, who has been often named as the son of Governor Thomas Johnson of Maryland, was actually the Governor's nephew. Benjamin and Governor Johnson were brothers.

Thomas, born in Annapolis about 1753, served as the secretary to the Board of Commissioners appointed by George Washington to plan the City of Washington, known also as the Federal City. The three commissioners were David Stuart of Virginia, and Thomas Johnson and Daniel Carroll, both of Maryland. Thomas Johnson, the head commissioner, was the uncle of Thomas Johnson Jr.

In 1795 Thomas was appointed postmaster of the District of Columbia, the first person to hold that job. The post office was run from his home which was a block or so east of the South Lawn of the White House, on F Street between 13th and 14th Streets NW. The streets were dirt at the time, so when it rained it was muddy, hard for postal delivery.

He did not have the job long, as on November 11 of that same year, a new postmaster, Christopher Richmond, was named. Thomas died the following month, December 1795.

Noted events in his life were:

- Occupation: 1 Nov 1793, Washington, D.C.<sup>3,50</sup> Served as secretary and bookkeeper to the Board of Commissioners appointed by George Washington to plan the Federal City.
- Occupation: Postmaster, City of Washington, 1795, Washington D.C.<sup>3,41,51</sup> Johnson was the first to hold this position. He ran the post office from his residence on F Avenue between 13th and 14th Streets. He held the office from 24 June 1795 to 11 Nov 1795, the month before he died.
- Residence: F Street N.W., between 13th & 14th Streets, 1795, Washington, D.C.<sup>40,41</sup> F Street N.W., between 13th & 14th Streets. Thomas and family probably moved to Washington from Maryland in the early 1790s.
- Probate: 5 Jan 1796, Annapolis, Anne Arundel, Maryland.<sup>42</sup> Administration of Estate given to John Davidson and James Cook, Catherine Johnson, wife of the deceased Thomas Johnson Jr., refuses to administer and wished the aboved named men to administer.
- Property: 3 Apr 1799, Washington, D.C.<sup>52</sup> The estate of Thomas Johnson Jr., decd., his dwelling house and all personal property, was to be sold by John Davidson, the surviving administrator of the estate. Much of the personal property was purchased by his widow, Catharine. The notice for the sale appeared in the *Centinel of Liberty* on 19 March 1799.
